TO. That brought to look for some pattern in the vicinity of TLS that fit to the photo. Found some



A close look with Gearth brought a good match.



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Look to the far back ground: the red roof and the longer white horizontal line provide and approach for line of sight. The forward tree tops grouping and their shape(look at shadows) confirm the spot(maybe the spot is a bit further north than the western end of the yellow line). The more northern would also be in line with the necessary flight pattern that is forced/planned to the line of the river Garonne in order to prevent ...



When 1st estimate was done next to XFW it was assumed to be taken from a high fix spot in order to be above the object (illusions).

But now(with that geo-scenario) - looking at the D-AVVL configuration (~2, VF215KCAS) it is clear >> That was a perfectly planned TOT(TimeOverTarget) Heli-chase. 'Chapeau' and Thanks.
